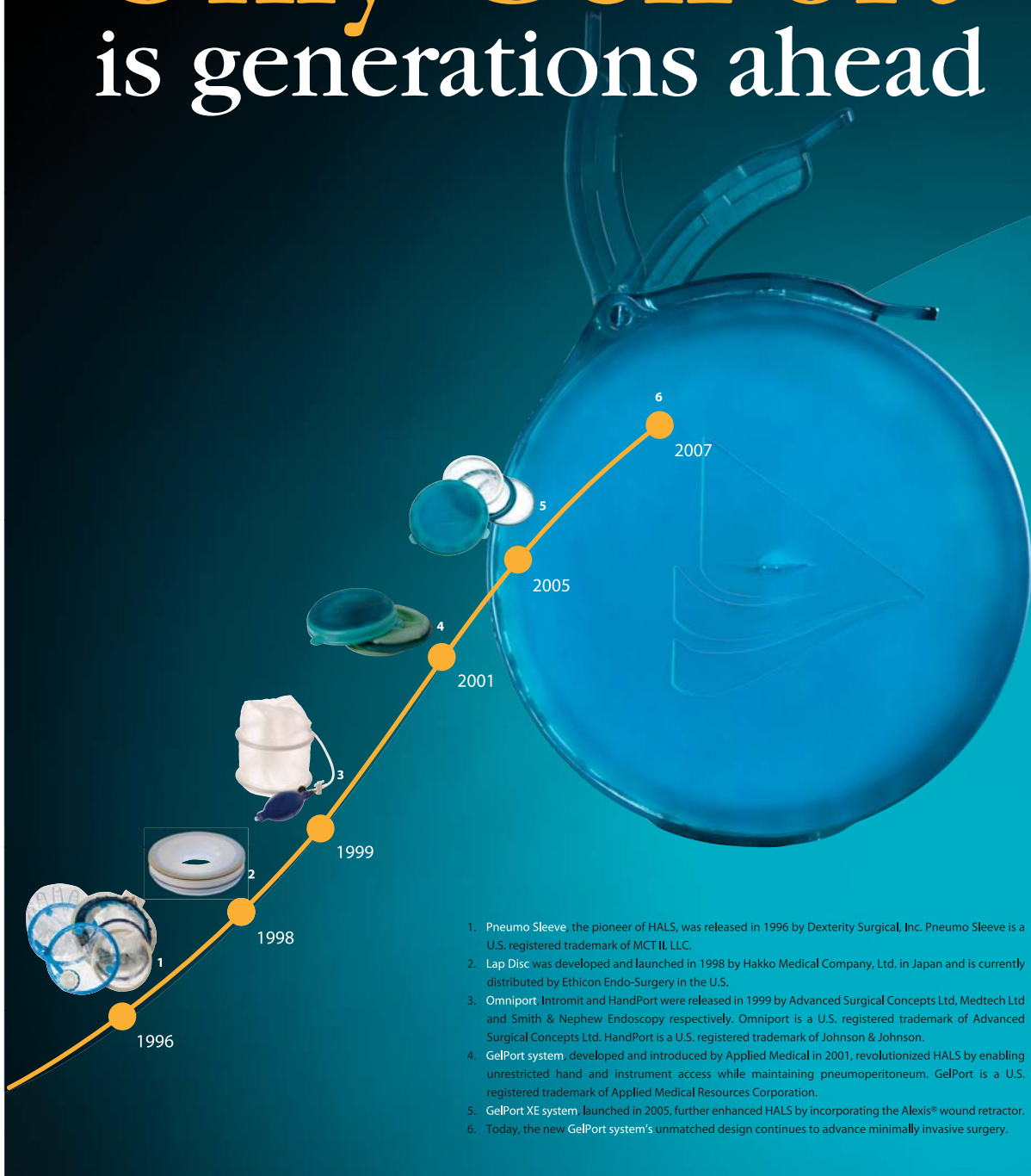

2. Lap Disc was developed and launched in 1998 by Hakko Medical Company, Ltd. in Japan and is currently distributed by Ethicon Endo-Surgery in the U.S.
3. Omniport, Intromit and HandPort were released in 1999 by Advanced Surgical Concepts Ltd, Medtech Ltd and Smith & Nephew Endoscopy respectively. Omniport is a U.S. registered trademark of Advanced Surgical Concepts Ltd. HandPort is a U.S. registered trademark of Johnson & Johnson.
4. GelPort system, developed and introduced by Applied Medical in 2001, revolutionized HALS by enabling unrestricted hand and instrument access while maintaining pneumoperitoneum. GelPort is a U.S. registered trademark of Applied Medical Resources Corporation.
5. GelPort XE system, launched in 2005, further enhanced HALS by incorporating the Alexis[®] wound retractor.
